The Intel International Science & Engineering Fair (Intel ISEF) is the world's largest pre-college celebration of science. Held annually in May, the Intel ISEF brings together over 1800 students from more than 75 nations to compete for scholarships, tuition grants, internships, scientific field trips and the grand prize, a \$75,000 college scholarship. You'll meet new friends, speak with Nobel Laureates and showcase your research on an international stage.

As a participant of the Covestro Pittsburgh Regional Science & Engineering Fair (PRSEF), you may submit a preliminary application to attend the Intel ISEF.

GET INVOLVED! To be considered for Intel ISEF, you must be registered as a Covestro Pittsburgh Regional Science & Engineering Fair participant, submit a Preliminary ISEF Student Application Form along with one copy of your research paper and email your research paper to prsef@carnegiesciencecenter.org by March 1, 2018. Judges review these papers prior to PRSEF. Selected students will be interviewed on Fair Day. Final selection will be determined by a panel of judges. Winners will be announced during the Awards Ceremony on Saturday, March 24, 2018. Winners must be available on or before April 3 for final paperwork submission to ISEF.
